Under-investment in military capacity by non-US NATO allies

Proliferation of house security system yard signs

Capital flight from a country because declining economy creates risk of revolution and expropriation of capital

Racial segregation of neighborhoods

Rahm Emanuel's proposal to raise property taxes only by half of what is needed to close pension gap

Underfunding of pledges for humanitarian assistance following natural disasters

Failure of the Afghan Army and Afghan National Police to be ready for U.S. troop withdrawals

Hospitals' inability to share electronic records with one another
